

New Venture Scout Hut

In April 1992 the old Venture Scout Hut - condemned some 15 years earlier! - finally met its end and was bulldozed to make space for some additional garaging units and hardstanding.

A new location beyond the bowling green was selected and surveyed. Negotiations for a Marley style prefabricated building were completed (FH securing a very generous discount!) and planning permission filed. Local bureaucracy held up work until December.

Soon the diggers were at work and although the weather now played its part in slowing up progress, a new concrete foundation and floor were poured, levelled and ready by mid February 1993. At half term the prefabricated components of the new 'hut' were delivered ready for the construction workers to set to and erect them into our new "home sweet home"!
