ups);

08.45hrs Lead passenger (staff) to check in and obtain boarding passes;

Times are approximate and schedule may vary depending on local circumstances and conditions. In the event of match cancellation, alternative activities may be arranged, typically additional swimming at Les Quennevais Sports Centre, Ten-Pin Bowling at the Fortress or visit to the German Military Underground Hospital at St Lawrence.

PB/CAB will travel in advance of teams in order to negotiate and advance-book meals and restaurants, establish secure overnight parking arrangements for minibuses, meet with assisting cricket officials from Jersey, confirm arrangements at venues and practice grounds, liaise with hotel owners/staff, re-assess and evaluate local hazards, conditions and facilities.


