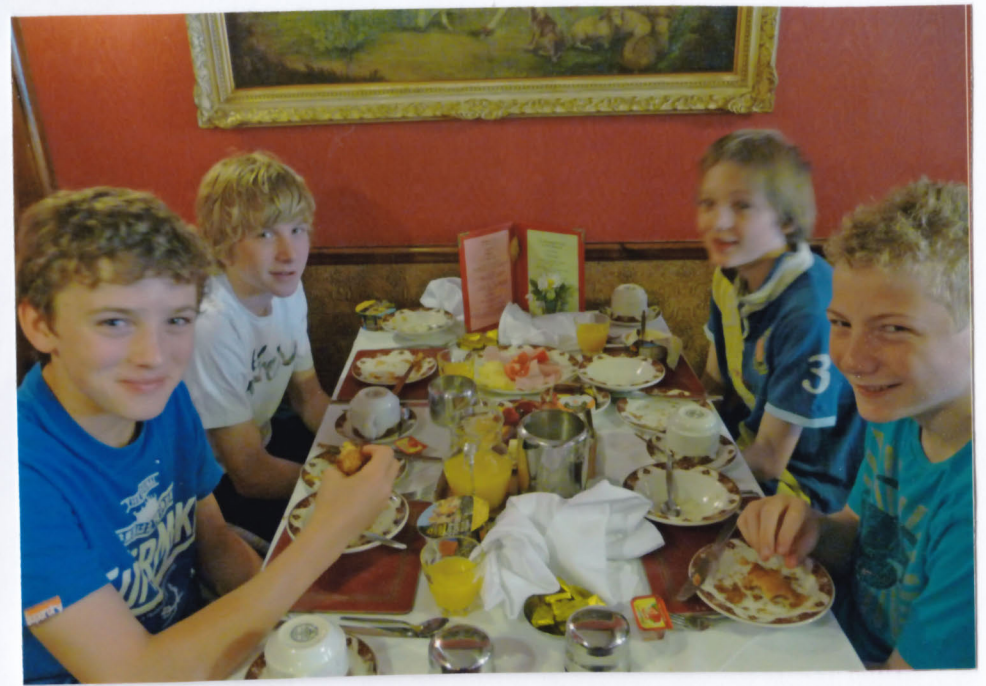

Daily Orders

Travel days

Departure – Monday 24th May

- 05.00hrs Assemble STRS; load minibuses;
05.20hrs Depart STRS;
Minibuses to travel "in convoy" (within visual range and mobile contact) and follow route (Gloucester to Weymouth) agreed at pre-tour staff briefing (checked last-minute for no delays/hold-ups);
Prior to departure, staff to confirm sailings as scheduled; in the event of postponement/cancellation due to bad weather, see course of action outlined in emergency plans.
One planned comfort stop – 15 mins maximum – on route.
- 08.35hrs ETA Weymouth Condor Ferries terminal;
08.45hrs Lead passenger (staff) to check in and obtain boarding passes; Ferry booking reference – 2639954. Boarding (ferry control).
10.00hrs Ferry departure. Staff to advise PB of time of departure.
13.40hrs ETA Ferry at Condor Ferries Terminal St Helier, Jersey. Disembark; meet up with PB/CAB with updates on local traffic, parking and hotel off-loading arrangements.
14.30hrs Arrive hotel; welcome and room allocations; settle in; change for practice sessions (at FB Fields);
15.30hrs Assemble for initial briefing and then transport to FB Fields.
16.00hrs Practice and net sessions; if wet, general fitness work.
18.00hrs Return to hotel; change and freshen up.
19.30hrs Meal in hotel dining room;
21.00hrs Welcome briefing, team meetings and selection.
22.00hrs Beddy-byes!
22.30hrs Lights out and sleep time! Staff rounds.

Return – Friday 28th May

- 07.00hrs Reveille; Staff to check ferry sailings on schedule.
07.30hrs Breakfast, Final Briefing & Hotel Thank-yous.
08.15hrs Complete packing, clear rooms; assemble with kit ready for minibuses; staff carry out room checks.
09.15hrs Load minibuses and prepare for departure.
09.35hrs Lead passenger (staff) to check in and obtain boarding passes; Ferry booking reference – 2639954. Boarding (ferry control).
10.35hrs Ferry departure; lunch on board ferry.
15.10hrs ETA Ferry at Condor Ferries Terminal Poole. Disembark;
Minibuses to travel "in convoy" (within visual range and mobile contact) and follow route (Gloucester to Weymouth) agreed at pre-tour staff briefing (checked last-minute for no delays/hold-

ups); PB to be informed of safe arrival on terra firma UK.
One planned comfort stop – 15 mins maximum – on route.
18.30hrs ETA STRS; unload minibuses; staff final de-brief; parents meet and collect pupils; staff secure kit and minibuses on school premises; staff notify PB/home contact of safe arrival.

Match Days (Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday)

07.15hrs	Reveille
08.00hrs	Breakfast
09.00hrs	Team Meetings, Room and Kit inspections
09.50hrs	Assemble at rear of hotel for minibus pickup to practice grounds
10:00-12.15hrs	Training and net practice - this will be at FB Sports Fields in St Helier or Les Quennevais sports complex at Red houses. Travel to practice sessions will be in team minibuses.
12.15-13.15hrs	Lunch – this will be taken either at FB Fields (al fresco), in the Les Quennevais sports centre café (reserved area dining) or on route to the Victoria College or Grainville grounds (pasta/delicatessen counter in Flower market).
13.30-18.30hrs	Matches - as detailed on separate tour details sheet. These will include a traditional “tea” break between innings.
18.30-19.00hrs	Return to Hotel; freshen up and change for evening meal and activities.
19.00-21.30hrs	Evening meal and activities; Tuesday – Fish ‘n Chips supper on beach at Gorey followed by beach games, and/or soccer match on village green, stroll along harbour pier; Wednesday – Meal in Hotel dining room followed by guided stroll around St Helier; Thursday – Tour Dinner & Awards at Pizza Express in reserved upper dining area; presentations and speeches, etc.
21.45hrs	Team meetings, Room & Kit inspections, quiet time and drinks.
22.30hrs	Beddy-byes!
22.45hrs	Lights out and sleep time! Final staff rounds (we hope!!)

Times are approximate and schedule may vary depending on local circumstances and conditions. In the event of wet weather causing matches to be abandoned, remaining time will be spent being sociable with home side players at their venue. In the event of match cancellation, alternative activities may be arranged, typically additional swimming at Les Quennevais Sports Centre, Ten-Pin Bowling at the Fortress or visit to the German Military Underground Hospital at St Lawrence.

PB/CAB will travel in advance of teams in order to negotiate and advance-book meals and restaurants, establish secure overnight parking arrangements for minibuses, meet with assisting cricket officials from Jersey, confirm arrangements at venues and practice grounds, liaise with hotel owners/staff, re-assess and evaluate local hazards, conditions and facilities.
